



Directions:

Church of the Holy Rood: Holybourne, GU34 3HD

From Alton or the A34, follow the signs for Holybourne, and enter the village on London Road. After 300m, you will pass St Andrews School on your left. 100m further on, turn left into Howards Lane. Follow the road, and the church will be on your right after 400 metres. There is limited parking on the road beside the church.

The White Hart: Holybourne, GU34 4EY

From Alton or the A34, follow the signs for Holybourne, and enter the village on London Road. The White Hart will be on your right after 800m.

From the church, head down church lane, turning left at the T junction. The White Hart will be on your right, after 50 metres.

There is ample parking behind the pub.

Jefs House (start point for the bike ride):

14 Albert Road, Alton, GU34 1LP

Albert road is located at the west end of Alton, adjacent to "The Butts", a triangular field.

From the centre of Alton, follow the main road (Butts Road) following signs for "other routes". You will pass the BP garage on your Left and after about 300m you will approach a pedestrian crossing. Before it, turn right, and immediately right again into Albert Road.

From The A34, Take the slipway marked "Alton" (NOT the roundabout) and follow the signs to Alton. You will reach a double roundabout. Turn right at the first roundabout and straight on at the second roundabout. You will pass under a railway bridge, and The Butts will be on your right. Pass the pedestrian crossing, and then turn left. Albert road is on your right after 15m.

From the M3, turn off at Junction 6, and follow the signs for Alton (A339). As you come into Alton, just past the 30mph sign, turn right (signposted "Alton/other routes").

Follow the road, until you pass under a bridge, and immediately reach a roundabout. Take the first exit and The Butts will be on your left. Pass the pedestrian crossing, and then turn left. Albert road is on your right after 15m.

No14 is on your right after 60m (the last house in the terrace, with a path down the side) Parking is on the adjacent streets.

Jubilee Playing fields (Start point for the walk to the brewery): Chawton Park Road, GU34 1ST

Follow the signs to “Sports Centre”, pass the Sports Centre on your left, and follow the road to a sharp 90 degree bend. The Car Park is on your left, before you reach the bridge.

Alton Station: Station Road, Alton, GU34 2PZ

Follow the signs to the station! Note, although it is paid parking, it is not normally checked at the weekend. You can also find parking on adjacent streets.

The Railway Arms: 26 Anstey Road, Alton, GU34 2RB

Follow the directions to the Station, The Railway Arms is opposite the junction of Station Approach and Anstey Road, with a train coming out of the front of the building – you can’t miss it! On entering the pub, head round to the right to get to the back room

Triple fff Brewery: Station Approach, Four Marks, GU34 5HN

From Alton head towards Four Marks. At the centre of the village is a set of pedestrian lights next to a “Tesco’s Express” Turn right onto Station Approach, just after the lights, and then left into the Brewery, after 50m.
